diameter:
1203 km

1. Cut out globe along thin solid lines.
2. Fold and then unfold the dashed lines.
3. Glue the poles together (tabs marked P).
4. Glue the equator (tab marked E).
5. Put glue on all remaining tabs.
6. Attach poles to equator.
